



### NOTE TO CUSTOMERS:


- For ease and speed of assembly we recommend that before you commence each step of the assembly that you identify all the parts required to complete that step.
- We recommend that where possible you allow sufficient space to assemble the item as close as possible to the place where it will be once assembled.
- For the protection of your furniture we recommend that the product is placed on protected surfaces during assembly to prevent any damage.
- During assembly do not over tighten, as this may damage the product.
- Please ensure you retain all the product packaging until the item completely assembled.
- Please periodically check all fittings and re-tighten as necessary.
- Please never allow any liquids to remain on your furniture as absorption can cause the wood to warp or finish to de-laminate.
- It is recommended that this item should be assembled by two adults.

## To insert a cam lock: (Please read below instructions before assembling)

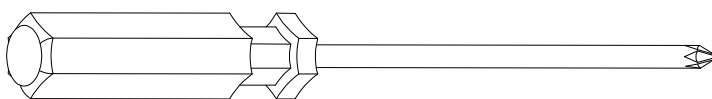
		<p><b>Diagram A</b></p> <p>1. Insert cam screw into hole as shown in diagram A .</p>
		<p><b>Diagram B</b></p> <p>Make sure not to insert the cam screw: Too deep as shown in figure B as this will cause the cam screw to be misaligned and unable to interlock properly.</p>
		<p><b>Diagram C</b></p> <p>Also avoid inserting the cam screw too close to the surface of the hole as shown in figure C, as this will cause the cam lock to be too loose, and not interlock properly.</p>

	<p>2. Connect the panels together.</p>
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	<p>3. When inserting the cam lock make sure the arrow of the cam lock faces the cam screw.</p>
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








	<p>4. To tighten the cam lock turn the cam lock clockwise 90-180 degree or until the arrow is facing opposite the place cam lock was inserted.</p> <p><b>NOTE: DO NOT USE AN AUTOMATIC SCREWDRIVER TO TIGHTEN CAM LOCKS.</b></p>

- 1). Insert Cam-Bolt (B2) & Wood Dowels (B1) into the holes on Bottom Panel (A4) and Top Panel (A1), then tighten Cam-Bolt (B2) with a Philips screwdriver.
- 2). Attached Magnets B11 to the bottom of Top Panel A1 using Screws B12.( There are pre-drilled holes).

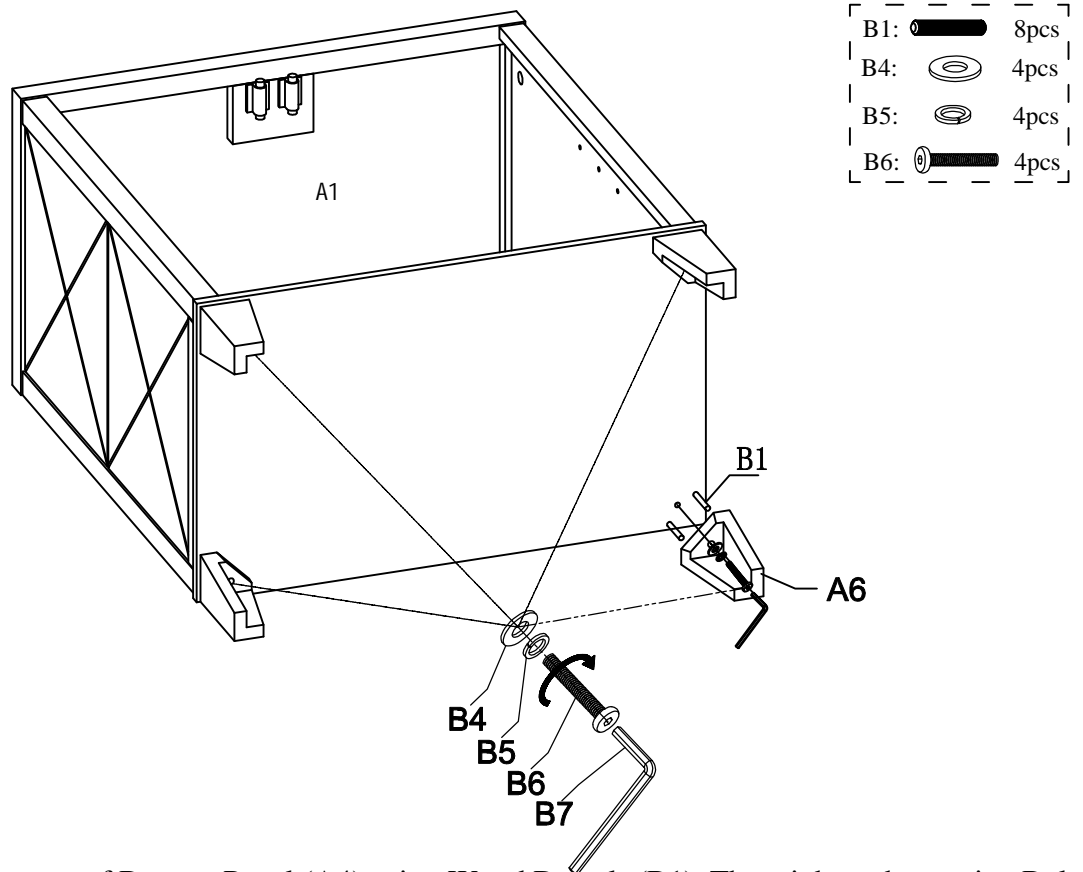
## Step 2:

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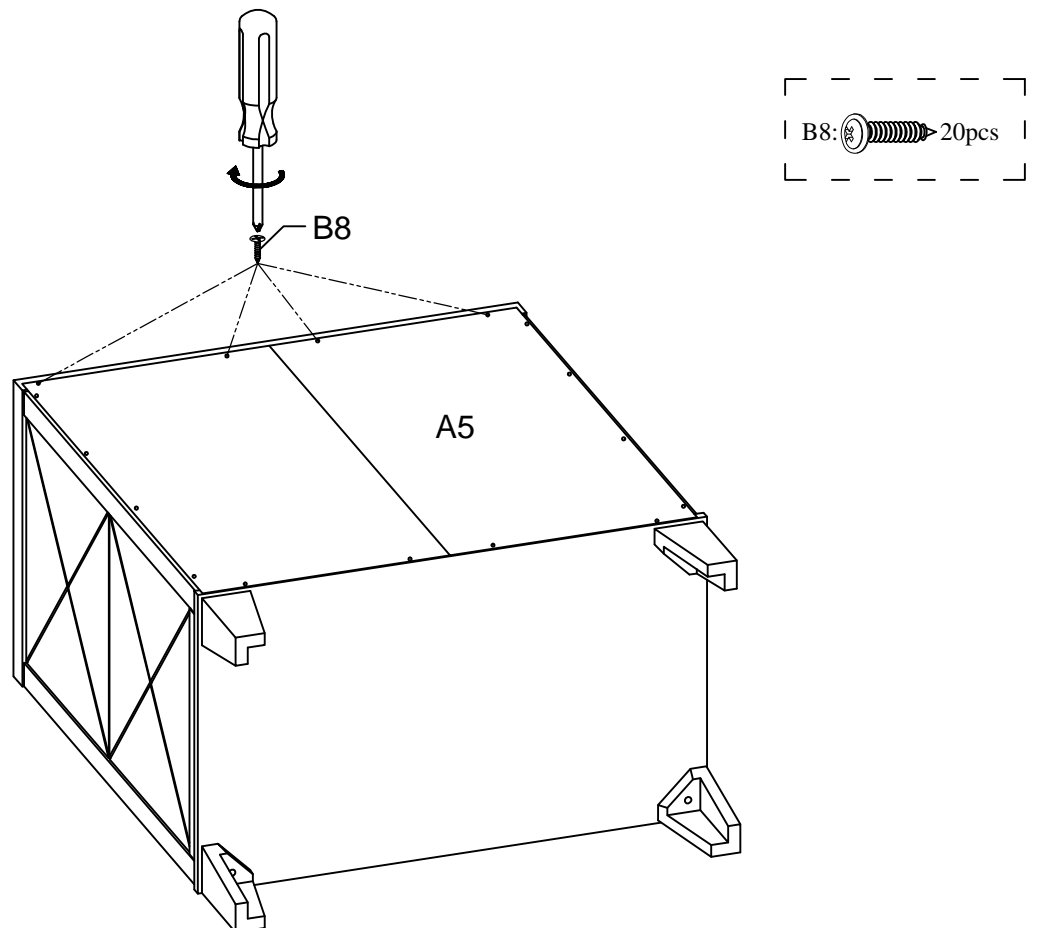
Attach Top Panel (A1) and Bottom Panel (A4) to Side Panels (A2&A3) by assembled Cam-Bolts (B2), Wood Dowel (B1) , then insert Cam-Locks (B3) into the holes of Side Panels(A2&A3)and tighten them with a Philips screwdriver.

### Step 3:



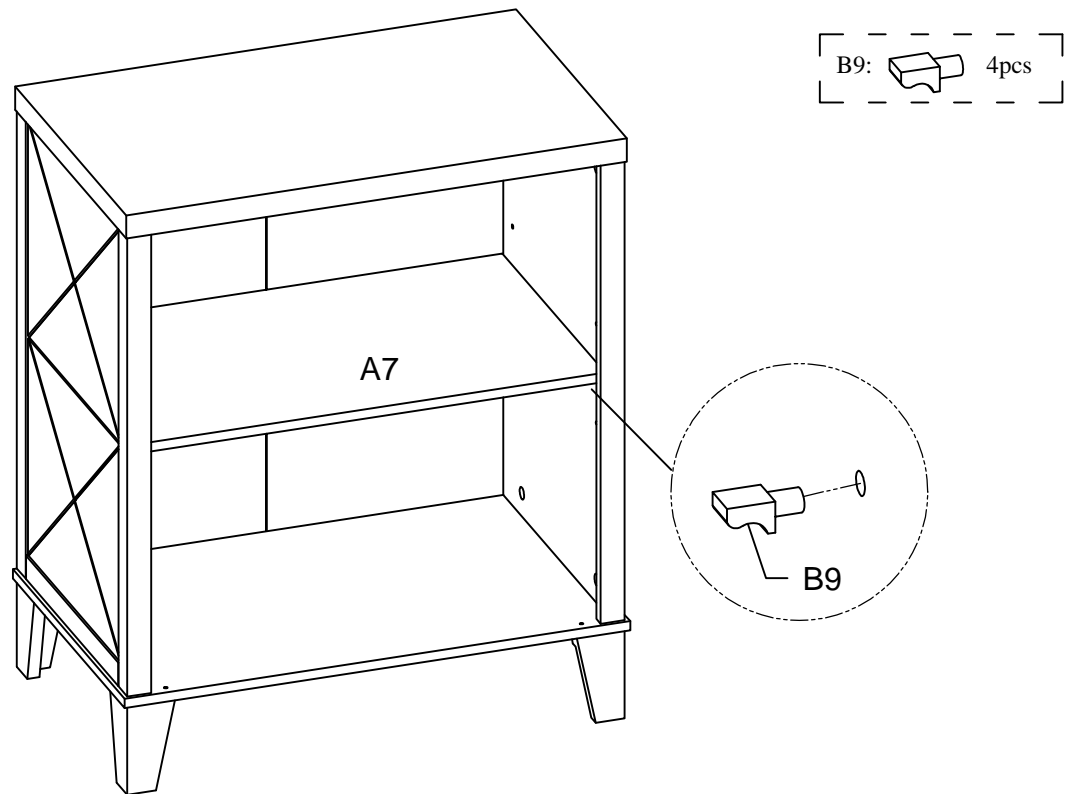
Attach Legs (A6) to the bottom of Bottom Panel (A4) using Wood Dowels (B1). Then tighten them using Bolts (B6) with Flat Washers (B4) and Spring Washers (B5) with Allen Wrench (B7).

### Step 4:



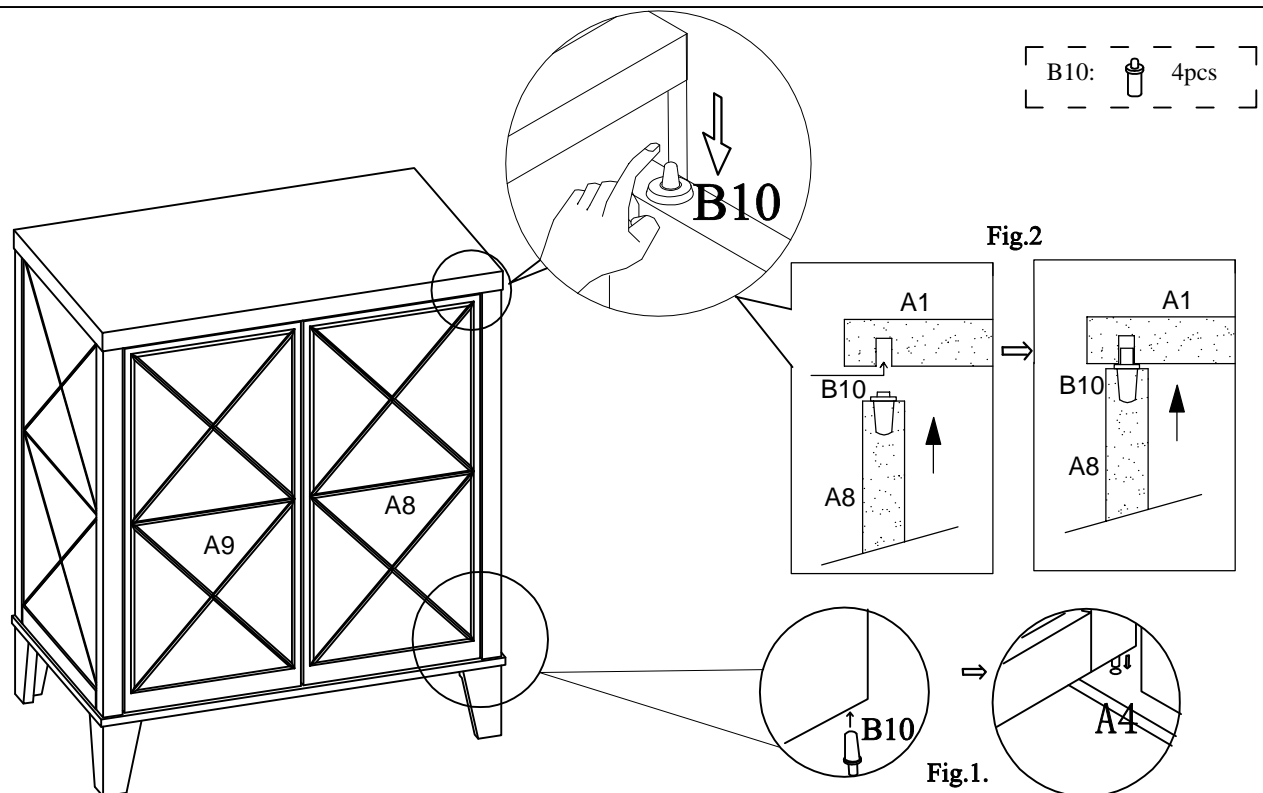
Assemble Back Panel (A5) to the back of this unit using Screws (B8) with a Philips screwdriver.

## Step 5:



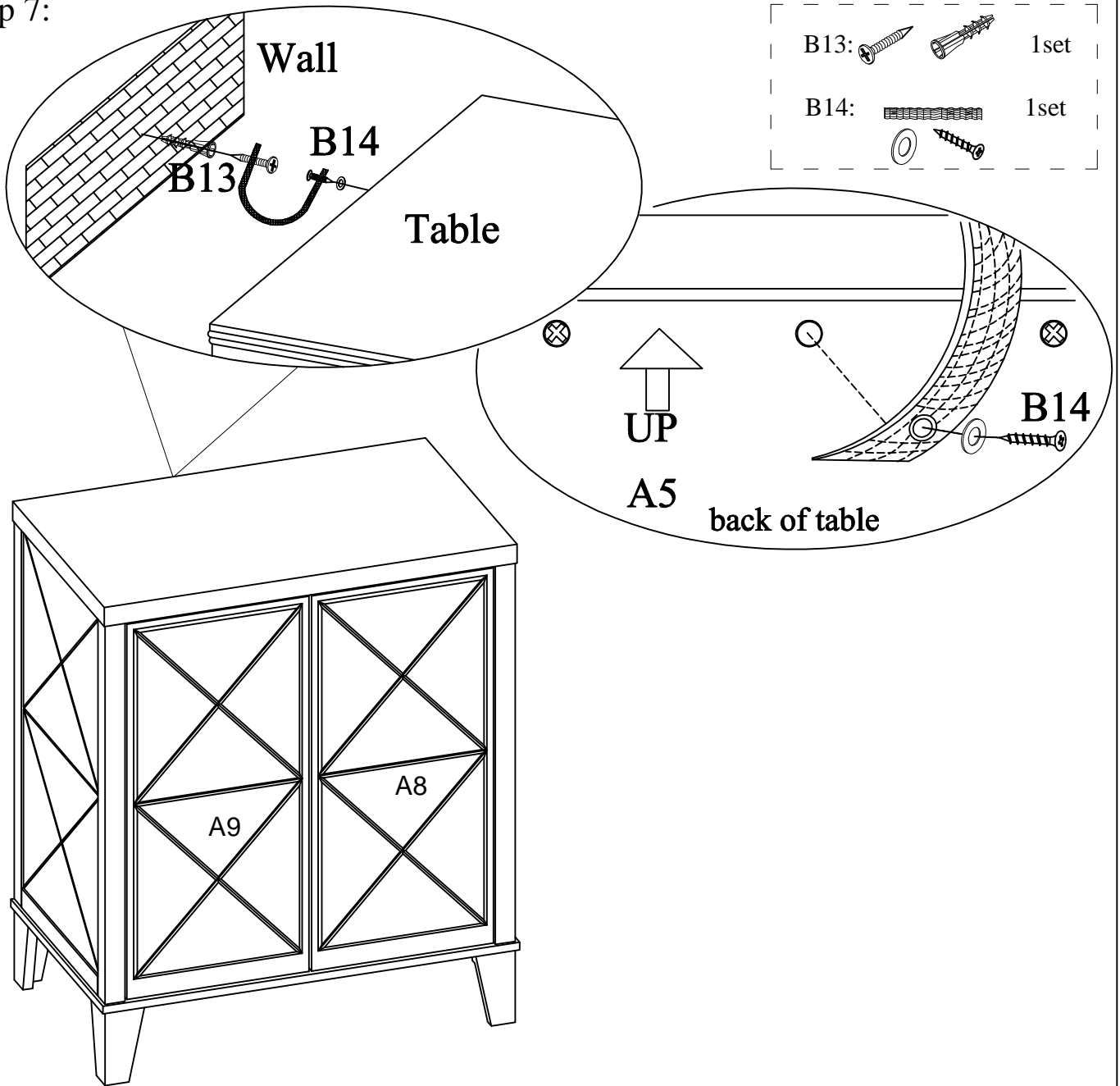
Insert Shelf Supports (B9) into the holes on Side Panels (A2&A3), then put Adjustable Shelf (A7) onto Shelf Supports (B9), please note holes are pre-drilled.

## Step 6:



- 1). Insert Door Pin (B10) into the hole on the bottom of Door Panel A8, then connect Door Panel (A8) to Bottom Panel A4 as drawing Fig.1.
- 2). Insert Door Pin B10 into the hole on the top of Door Panel (A8), then press down Door Pin B10 ( see Fig.2.) and hold the door panel carefully into the cabinet with the door pin popping up into the hole of Top Panel (A1).
- 3). Repeat the above steps to assemble the other door panel (A9).

For your safety, please attach this unit to the wall by Anti-tip Kit B14 and Anchor with screw B13.
