



#### NOTE TO CUSTOMERS

- For ease and speed of assembly we recommend that before you commence each step of the assembly that
  - you identify all the parts required to complete that step.
- We recommend that where possible you allow sufficient space to assemble the item as close as possible to the place where it will be once assembled.
- For the protection of your furniture we recommend that the product is placed on protected surfaces during
  - assembly to prevent any damage.
- During assembly do not over tighten, as this may damage the product.
- Please ensure you retain all the product packaging until the item completely assembled.
- Please periodically check all fittings and re-tighten as necessary.
- Please never allow any liquids to remain on your furniture as absorption can cause the wood to warp or finish to de-laminate.
- It is recommended that this item should be assembled by two adults.


#### To use a cam lock: (Please read below instructions before assembling)



1. Insert cam screw into hole as shown in diagram A.

Make sure not to insert the cam screw: Too deep as shown in figure B as this will cause the cam screw to be misaligned and unable to interlock properly.

Also avoid inserting the cam screw too close to the surface of the hole as shown in figure C, as this will cause the cam lock to be too loose, and not interlock properly.



#### Note:

- Read these instructions carefully before assembling.
- Tools required : Phillips screwdriver, flat screwdriver.
- Find a clean, smooth area on which to work, such as a carpet, in order to avoid scratching the wood surfaces.
- Wait to dispose of the packing material until assembly is complete and all parts and hardware are accounted for.
- Two or more people might be required for assembly.




# **WARNING:**

# Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from furniture tip-over. To help prevent tip-over:

- Place heaviest item in the lowest drawers.
- Unless specifically designed to accommodate, do not set TVs or other heavy objects on top of this product.
- Never allow children to climb or hang on drawers, doors or shelves.
- Never open more than one drawer at a time.(OR)
- Do not defeat or remove the drawer interlock system.
   Use of tip-over restraints may only reduce, but not eliminate the risk of tip-over.


Assemble Front Cross Bar (A5) and Back Cross Bar(A6) to Divider (A4) using Screws (B4) and Wood Dowels(B1).







Attach Magnet (B9) to the bottom of Divider (A4) using Screws (B6), please note the holes are pre-drilled.



Insert Wood Dowels (B1) to the holes on Lower Side Panels (A2) &(A3). Then tighten Cam-bolts (B2) to Side Panels (A2) & (A3). Please note holes are pre-drilled.


Assemble Lower Side Panels (A2&A3) to Divider (A4), Bottom Panel (A7) and Cross Bar (A5&A6) inserting Cam Bolts(B2) & Wood Dowels (B1), insert Cam Locks (B3) into holes on the bottom of Divider (A4), Bottom Panel (A7) and Cross Bar (A5&A6), then tighten them.






Insert Wood Dowels (B1) to the holes on Upper Side Panels (A8) &(A9). Then tighten Cam-bolts (B2) to Upper Side Panels (A8) & (A9). Please note holes are pre-drilled.









- 1. Assemble Glass Holder (A10) to Upper Back Panel (A11) using Wood Dowels (B1) and Screws (B4).
- 2. Attach Upper Side Panel (A8)&(A9) to Upper Back Panel (A11) and Glass holder(A10) by inserting Cam-bolts (B2) and Wood Dowels (B1).
- 3. Insert Cam-locks (B3) into the holes on Upper Back Panel (A11) & Glass Holder (A10), then tighten them.






Insert Cam-bolts (B2) to holes on Top Panel (A1), then tighten them.




Assemble Top Panel (A1) to Upper Side Panels (A8) & (A9) and Upper Back Panel (A11) using Wood Dowels (B1) and Screws (B4).



Assemble Top Panel (A1) to Lower Side Panels (A2) & (A3) by inserting Cam-bolts and using Wood Dowels (B1). Insert Cam Locks (B3) into holes on the Side panels (A2) & (A3), then tighten them.










Attach Lower Back Panels (A12) to Lower Side Panels (A2) & (A3), Divider (A4) and Bottom Panel (A7) using Screws (B6).

Step 11





Attach Handles (B7) to Doors (A13) & (A14) using Bolts (B8).



- 1: Connect Door (A14) to Bottom Panel (A7) as below Fig.1.
- 2: Press the upper pin on Door (A14) see Fig 2. and insert Door (A13) carefully into the cabinet with the upper pin poping up into the holes of Divider (A4).
- 3. Insert Shelf Support (B5) into the holes on Side Panels (A2) & (A3).
