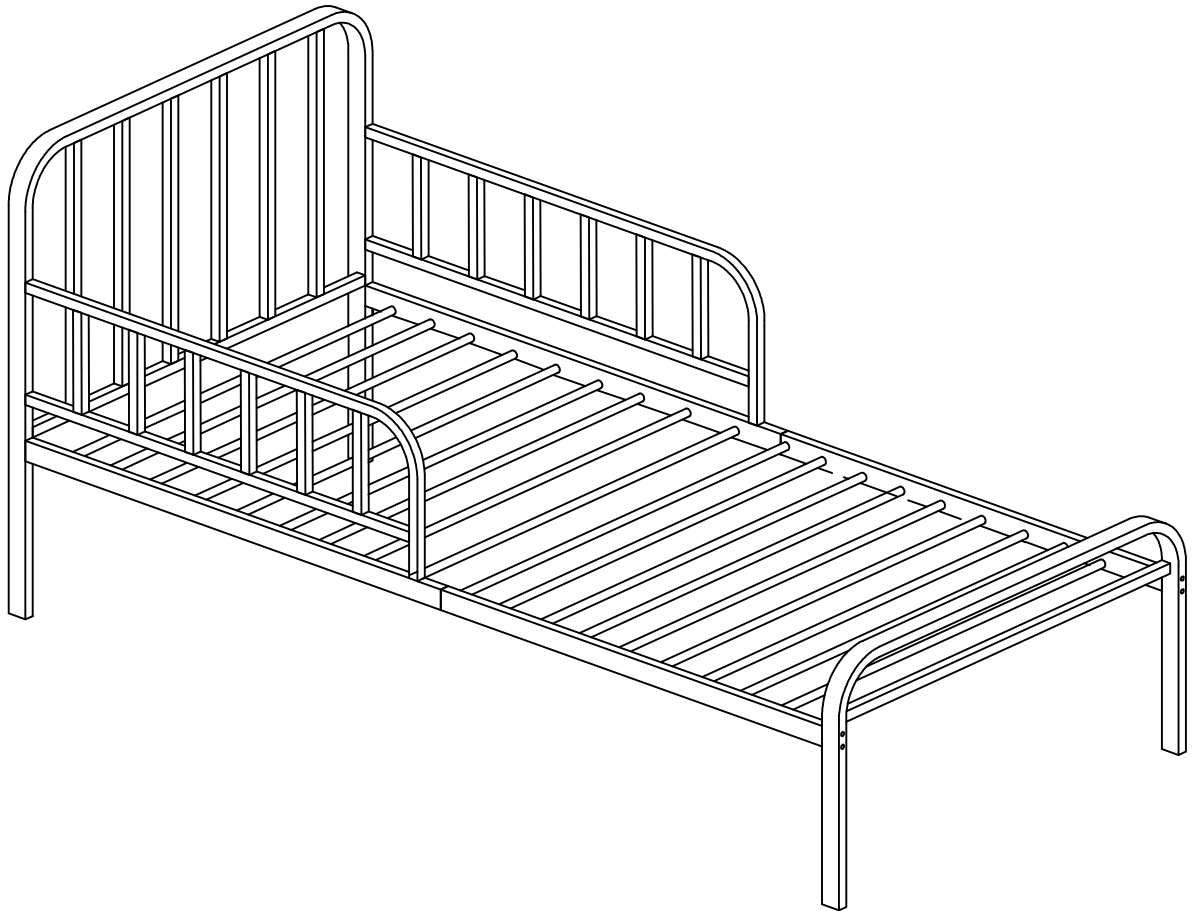

NOTE TO CUSTOMERS:

- For ease and speed of assembly we recommend that before you commence each step of the assembly that you identify all the parts required to complete that step.
- We recommend that where possible you allow sufficient space to assemble the item as close as possible to the place where it will be once assembled.
- For the protection of your furniture we recommend that the product is placed on protected surfaces during assembly to prevent any damage.
- During assembly do not over tighten, as this may damage the product.
- Please ensure you retain all the product packaging until the item completely assembled.
- Please periodically check all fittings and re-tighten as necessary.
- It is recommended that this item should be assembled by two adults.

Dear Customer:

Thank you for selecting one of our beds. Before assembling your bed, please read this manual carefully.

WARNINGS

Follow the warnings appearing on one of the upper bunk bed end structures and on the carton.

WARNING

INFANTS HAVE DIED IN TODDLER BEDS FROM ENTRAPMENT.

Openings in and between bed parts can entrap head and neck of a small child.

NEVER use bed with children younger than 15 months.

ALWAYS follow assembly instructions.

WARNING

STRANGULATION HAZARD

NEVER place bed near windows where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.

NEVER suspend strings over bed.

NEVER place items with a string, cord, or ribbon, such as hood strings or pacifier cords, around a child's neck. These items may catch on bed parts.

CAUTION

ENTRAPMENT HAZARD

To avoid dangerous gaps, any mattress used in this bed shall be a full-size crib mattress at least 51-5/8 in. (310mm) in length, 27-1/4 in. (690mm) in width, and 4 in. (100mm) in thickness.






CAUTION:

Check this product for damaged hardware, loose joints, missing parts or sharp edges before and after assembly and frequently during use. Do not use this toddler bed if any parts are missing, damaged or broken. Contact KB FURNITURE CO., (BRONX, NY) for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. Do not substitute parts.




CAUTION:

Do not use a water mattress with this toddler bed. Children can suffocate on soft bedding. Never place additional padding under a child. Strings can cause strangulation! Do not place items with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. Do not suspend strings over a toddler or attach strings to toys. To help prevent strangulation tighten all fasteners. A child can trap parts of the body or clothing on loose fasteners.

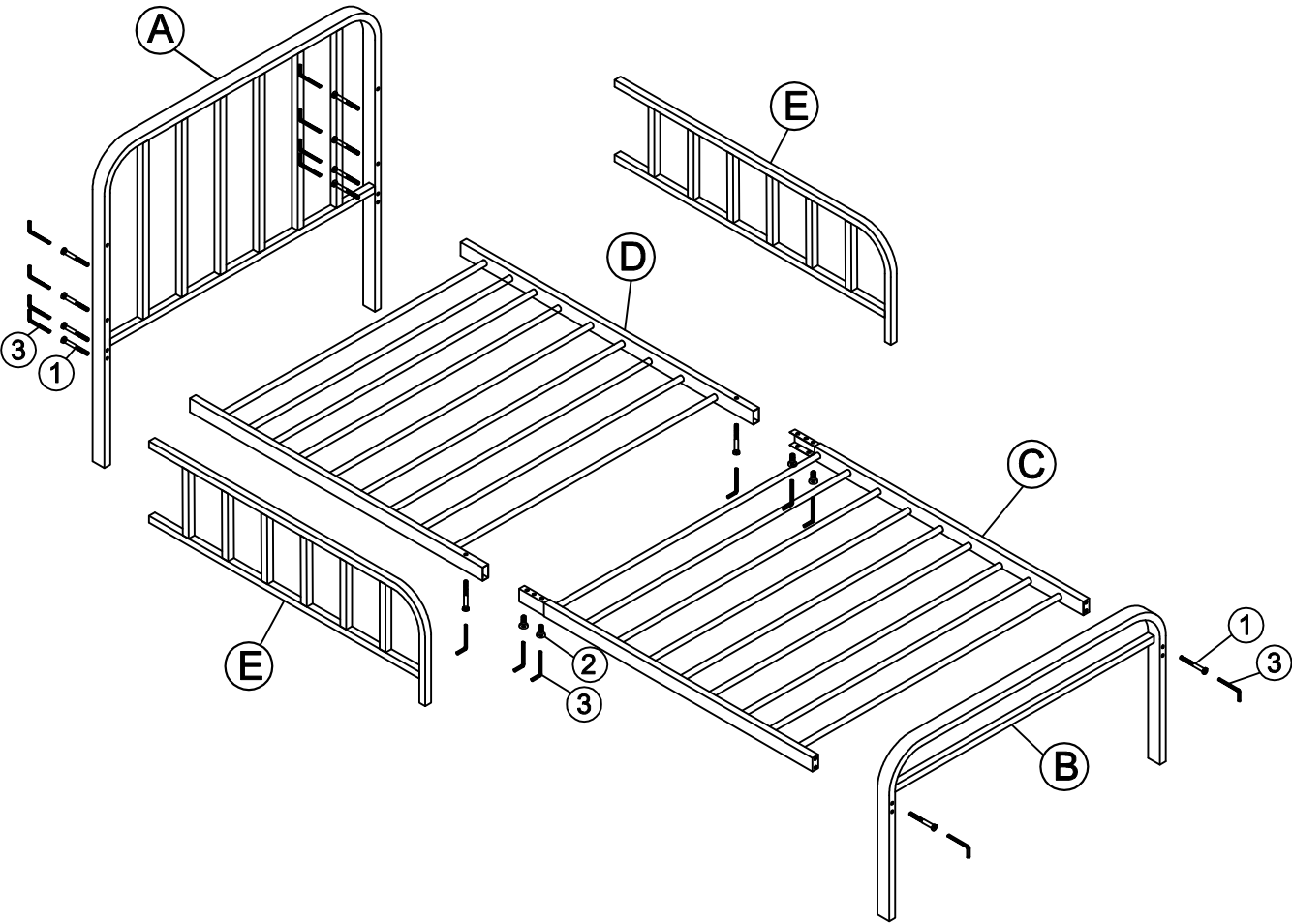

Assemble Headboard (A) and Footboard (B) to Platforms (C) &(D) using Bolts (1) as shown above. Please make sure the headboard & footboard in the correct positions before attach Bolts B1, refer to Fig.1. & Fig.2.

Note: Do not tighten bolts until Step 3.
